Local officials worked with Bi-State Regional Commission staff to prepare an update of the Quad Cities Long Range Transportation Plan. It includes \$5 billion in proposed transportation investments for roads, transit, and trails. Projects identified in the plan are eligible for federal and state transportation funds.
